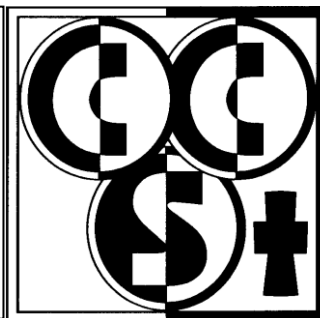

Note:

The government no longer reports Key Stage attainment using levels. Key Stage 2 national curriculum test outcomes are instead reported as scaled scores, where 100 represents the expected standard and, for 2019, 110 represents the higher standard.

At Key Stage 2, teacher assessment is reported for writing.

Key 1 to Key Stage 2 progress is calculated differently from previously and the national average is 0.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress, it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points.
