

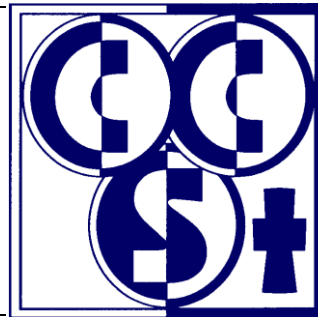

- Household – Toilet paper, laundry detergent, washing up liquid

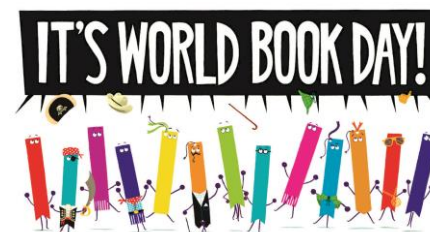

### World Book Day (Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March):

On Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March we will be celebrating World Book Day in school.

We are asking children to come in **non-uniform on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March**; this can be book character dress ups, snuggle up with a book Oodles or comfies ready to read!

All children came home prior to half term with a **World Book Day Token**. This can be spent at any independent Bookstore as well as: Asda, Lidl, Sainsburys, Tesco, The Works, Waterstones and WHSmith.

We have planned a series of activities to celebrate world book day in class - teachers have planned activities to fit in with their class activities and timetable.

Additionally, in order to celebrate our love of books we will be also hosting a number of events:

A **Book Swap** (if your child brings in a book they can swap for another book) on **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March (in school time)**.

**Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March - Extreme Reading Competition:** The idea is to bring in a picture and short explanation of yourself engrossed in some extreme reading; this could be where you are reading, how you are reading or other wacky ideas! The most unusual entry from each year group will be awarded a small prize and all entries will be displayed in school.

**All entries must be received by Thursday 5th March and winners will be announced Monday 9th March.**

All entries will need to be printed out please. Please hand in your entries (with your name and class on the back) to your teacher.

**Parent and child 'Drop in and Read'** session on **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March 3.00-3.30pm**. There is no need to book - just turn up ready to enjoy a book or two in your child's classroom.
