The more cans we collect, the more money we will raise!

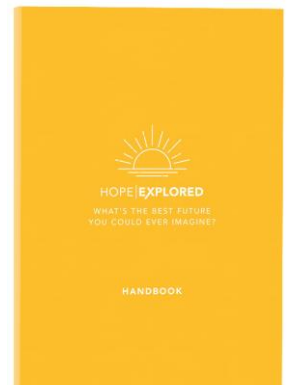
Please collect, crush and send into school your aluminium drinks cans to help us with our year long challenge! Thank you.
