

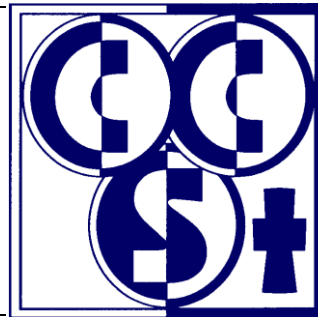

Data Collection Forms

Last week all children came home with a Data Collection Form. It is vital that these are completed, signed and returned to school as soon as possible, **even if there are no changes**, to ensure that our records are kept fully up to date. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

Flu Immunisation Forms

Please return these forms to the school office indicating if your child is / is not having the flu immunisation. Please note that the date of immunisation is the 14th October 2025.

PE Kit and Earrings

Can I please ask that children have their PE kit in school at all times and that in order for a child to be excused from Physical Education lessons ideally a Doctor's note should be provided (pupils cannot excuse themselves from the lesson!). Children will get changed for PE in school.

Following Safe Practice in PE Guidance, paragraph 2.14.8 the removal of all personal effects, including earrings is recommended to establish a safe working environment. We recommend removing earrings at home prior to PE lessons, and if you are unsure which day your child has PE, please check with their class teacher.

If your child cannot remove their earrings (due to a recent piercing or medical condition) then please provide a signed note to explain the reason that earrings cannot be removed.

Earrings must be safely taped up at home on PE days, so that when the child arrives in school they are ready to participate in PE. Please note that school staff cannot apply tape.

PE is a curriculum requirement and we thank you for your support in preparing your child for this lesson.

Parking

As with most schools, parking is an issue at the start and end of the school day. However, we are very fortunate to have the use of Ball Grove Car Park, which has abundant spaces for parents to park up easily, and then cross safely at the patrol crossing.

We politely ask that you use this car park and observe the following **restrictions**:

- ❖ **Parking outside the school gates or on the zig zag lines.**
- ❖ **Parking on the track which is reserved for staff parking.**
- ❖ **Irresponsible and illegal parking causing a major safety hazard to others using the road and the pavements.**
- ❖ **Obstructing traffic flow and preventing access for emergency vehicles on Bent Lane and Keighley Road.**
- ❖ **Parking in residents' parking spaces/entrances.**
