

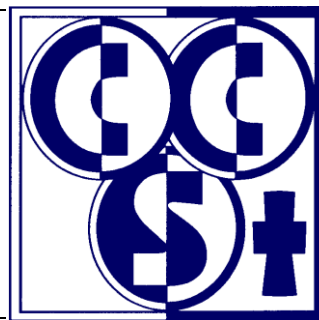

SIAMS Inspection Success – A Celebration of Flourishing

We are delighted to share the publication of our recent SIAMS (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools) report, which recognises the exceptional work taking place across our school community and celebrates the positive impact of our Christian vision on the lives of our children, staff and families.

The inspection found that our **aspirational Christian vision is deeply embedded throughout Christ Church**, enabling pupils and adults to flourish academically, socially and emotionally. Inspectors highlighted the strong culture of **trust, love and wellbeing** that permeates school life and supports everyone within our community.

Among the report's many strengths, inspectors recognised:

- A Christian vision that is well understood and lived out across the whole school community.
- Collective worship that inspires, includes and provides significant opportunities for spiritual growth.
- Positive relationships and wellbeing being consistently prioritised throughout the curriculum and beyond.
- Pupils being given structured opportunities to explore justice, responsibility and advocacy, enabling them to challenge injustice and support others with confidence.
- Strong partnerships with the church, diocese and local community that enrich school life and contribute to pupils' spiritual, moral and cultural development.

This outcome is a testament to the dedication of our staff, governors, families, church partners and, most importantly, our wonderful pupils, who demonstrate our values every day. We are immensely proud of what has been achieved together and grateful for the inspector's affirmation of the work taking place within our school. While celebrating these successes, we
